Dear Parents/Carers

We would like to provide some reassurance to you all following the letter that was sent yesterday regarding the data breach.

The data breach that has taken place did not involve information that was shared publicly. The affected data was stored on a personal device belonging to a staff member.

The information involved in this incident remained confidential and had not been disclosed to the public. However, the storage of sensitive data on a staff member's personal device introduced a vulnerability, which ultimately resulted in the breach.

It is important to reassure all concerned that the information compromised in this breach was not made available in the public domain. The incident was limited to data stored privately on an employee's personal device, and steps are being taken to address the vulnerability and protect the integrity of confidential information.

Please also be reassured that this matter has been taken very seriously and it has been reported to the Information Commissioners Office (ico.org.uk) which is the relevant body in this case. We are awaiting their response.


